Attended the Riverside Tranist Agency (RTA) Board of Directors Meeting.\*



#### 1. Ridership

• Total ridership for August was up 5% compared to August 2023. GoMicro took a major jump and was up 40% compared to last August.

#### 2. Youth Ride Free

• Youth continue to ride free with RTA on all fixed route and GoMicro buses now through June 30, 2025.

## 3. Service Change

• On September 8th, RTA adopted a service change to increase route frequencies and optimize routes to better serve our customers. The new Ride Guides and updates are available on the RTA website.

### 4. Free Day

• RTA gave 9,736 free rides on Car Free Day, September 22. Customers enjoyed free rides all day on all fixed route and GoMicro buses.

### 5. Bus Stop Strategic Policy Updates

• The Board approved the updated Bus Stop Strategic Policy. The policy outlines how bus stop amenities are equitably and sustainably allocated across the large service area of western Riverside County. New sections include language related to VMT mitigation for new developments and maintenance responsibilities for shelters not owned by RTA.
