Eligibility

To register to vote in California, you must be:

- A United States citizen and a resident of California
- 18 years old or older on Election Day
 - Pre-register at 16 – vote at 18
- Not currently serving a state or federal prison term for the conviction of a felony
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court

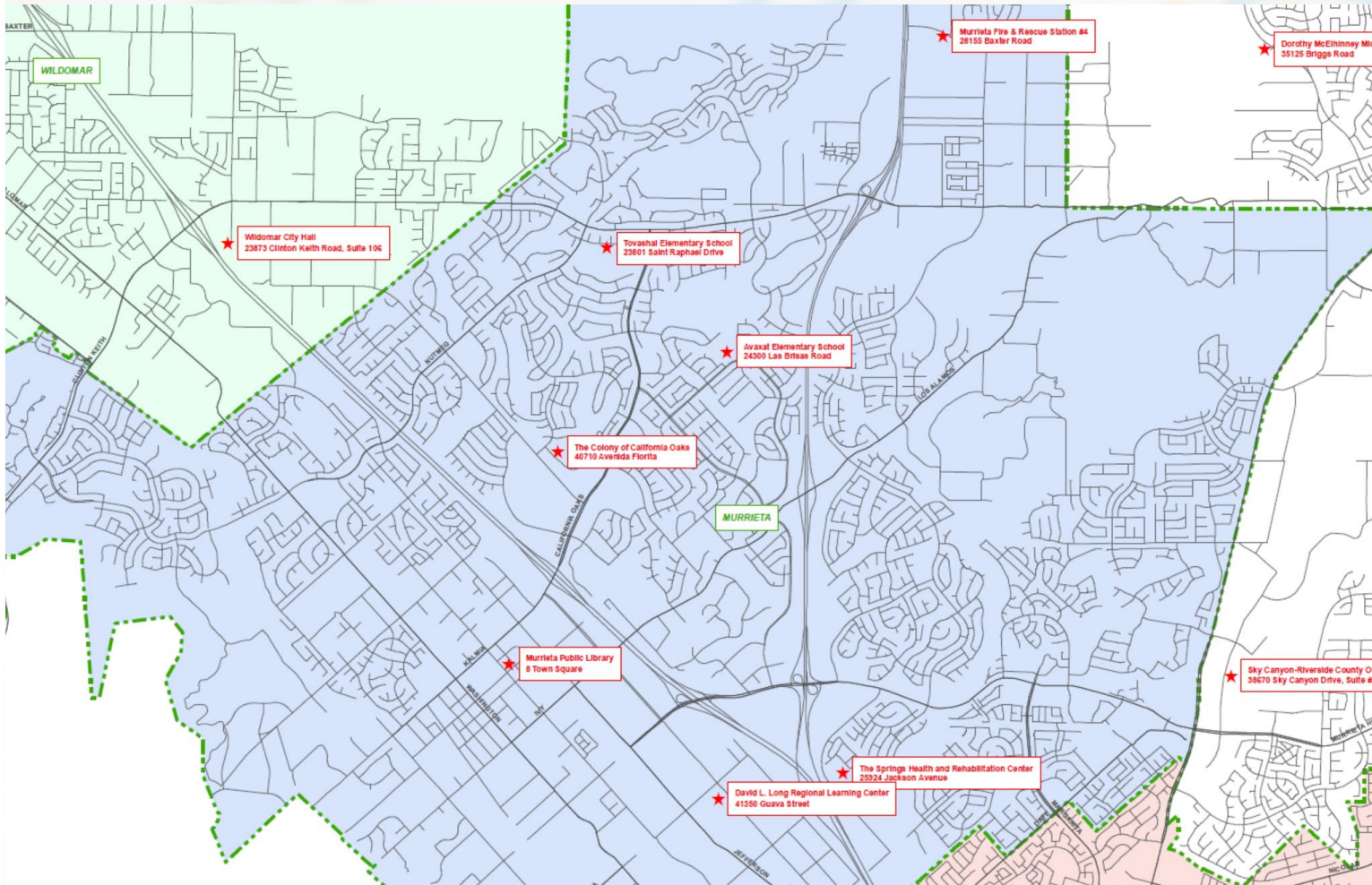

Important Dates - 2024

September 26 – October 21	Voter Information Guides are mailed out
October 4 - 10:00 AM	Riverside County Registrar of Voters Performs Logic and Accuracy Voting System Testing
October 7	Vote by Mail Ballots begin to be mailed
October 21	Last Day to Register to Vote*
October 26	Early In-Person Voting Begins
November 5	Election Day
December 5	Last Day for County to certify the Election
December 3 or 17	City to Declare Results and Install New Officers

* Same Day Voter Registration, known as Conditional Voter Registration in state law, is a safety net for Californians who miss the deadline to register to vote or update their voter registration information for an election.
