

**RESOLUTION NO. 26- 4927**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGE AND DESIGNATION OF A PICK-UP/DROP-OFF ZONE ON KINGWOOD ROAD ADJACENT TO VINTAGE RESERVE PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Murrieta (City) received a request from the Murrieta Valley Unified School District (MVUSD) to allow a pedestrian walkway from the school playground into Vintage Reserve Park near Buchanan Elementary School as a way to reduce congestion along Torrey Pines Road during pick-up and drop-off times; and

**WHEREAS**, a license agreement between the City and MVUSD was approved at the October 7, 2025 City Council meeting authorizing the construction and maintenance of the gate and sidewalk by MVUSD; and

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared a signing and striping plan for installation of a designated pick-up/drop-off zone on Kingwood Road adjacent to Vintage Reserve Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the City mailed letters to approximately 125 residents in the vicinity of Vintage Reserve Park, notifying them of the potential signing and striping changes to Kingwood Road, and invited them to attend the Traffic Commission meeting held on November 19, 2025 to voice any concerns with the proposed changes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Traffic Commission approved the installation of a designated pick-up/drop-off zone on Kingwood Road adjacent to Vintage Reserve Park at its November 19, 2025 meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, per City of Murrieta Municipal Code 10.32.030, no stopping zones and no parking areas that are not associated with the establishment of left-turn lanes, right-turn lanes, vehicle maneuvering zones, and sight clearance zones must be established by Resolution of the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the installation of a designated pick-up/drop-off zone on Kingwood Road adjacent to Vintage Reserve Park near Buchanan Elementary School is approved.
