RESOLUTION 25-4900

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023/24

WHEREAS, on August 22, 1974, the President of the United States signed into law the Housing and Community Act of 1974 (Act); and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of Title I of the Act are the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low- and moderate-income; and

WHEREAS, for at least the past 10 years the City of Murrieta (City) has participated in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program which was established under the Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the City of Murrieta ("City") receives an annual allocation of CDBG funds from the County of Riverside ("County"); and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates that it will receive approximately five hundred ninety-six thousand seven hundred dollars (\$596,700) in CDBG funds in the Fiscal Year 2026/27; and

WHEREAS, the City may allocate up to fifteen percent (15%) of the allocation for public service projects that meet the CDBG criteria; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside will retain thirteen percent (13%) of the allocation for administrative expenses; and

WHEREAS, the City may allocate up to seven percent (7%) of the allocation to the City's administrative expenses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, consistent with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) program rules on eligibility, and in accordance with the established City Council funding priorities, allocates CDBG funds to a number of programs and activities in support of HUD's National Objectives to primarily benefit low and moderate-income persons, or serve to minimize the effects of slums or blight, or provide for urgent needs; and

WHEREAS, the City has posted information regarding the CDBG Program as required by law and, after notice duly given as required by law, held a public hearing on December 2, 2025, to consider approving the City's proposed Community Development Block Grant Program for fiscal year 2026-2027, and evidence was heard and presented from all persons interested in affecting said proposal, from all persons protesting the same and from members of the City staff, and the City Council has reviewed, analyzed and studied said proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The CDBG projects, FY 2026-2027 funding allocations, shown below are hereby approved as the City's CDBG Program for Fiscal Year 2026-2027:
