

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-4921**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (CAL OES) HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS AS PART OF THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2023 HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$93,423.75; AND AMEND THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (CIP) BUDGET FOR FY 2025/26 TO APPROPRIATE THE GRANT FUNDS OF \$93,423.75 AND \$31,141.25 FROM GENERAL FUND CAPITAL UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE INTO CIP NO. 10044 FOR COMPLIANCE WITH GRANT LOCAL FUND MATCH REQUIREMENTS, AND AMEND THE FY 2025/26 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCREASE THE GRANT REVENUES AND GRANT EXPENDITURES BUDGETS**

**WHEREAS**, on February 7, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 23-4638, accepting the Fiscal Year 2023 Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant Award in the amount of \$327,957.84 and Amending the Fiscal Year 2022/23 Operating Budget to Allocate and Appropriate the Grant Funds and the Local Match Funds, including CIP No. 10044; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 7, 2024, the City Council awarded a construction contract for Fire Station 1 and City Hall Emergency Generator Project, CIP No. 10044, to Pramira, Inc. in the amount of \$524,422, with a 20% construction contingency; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 3, 2025, the City Council approved Resolution No. 25-4836, approving the Capital Improvement Plan Budget for Fiscal Year 2025/26, and the Fiscal Years' 2025/26 to 2029/30 Capital Improvement Plan, which included the Fire Station 1 Site Improvements Project, CIP No. 21019; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 29, 2025, City Staff received a Notification of Approval of Supplemental Funds for the Cal OES Fiscal Year 2023 Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant Program (FEMA-4558-DR-CA, Project #PJ0257, FIPS #065-50076, Supplement #118) in the amount of \$93,423.75 to be used for construction of the Fire Station 1 and City Hall Emergency Generator Replacement Project, CIP No. 10044; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms of the Grant supplemental funds require a local match requirement totaling \$31,141.25; and

**WHEREAS**, City Staff requests the local match funds in the amount of \$31,141.25 be appropriated into CIP No. 10044 from General Fund Capital (Fund 112) unassigned fund balance; and

**WHEREAS**, to accommodate these requests an amendment to the Operating and CIP Budgets for FY 2025/26 will be required; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to accept the supplemental Grant..

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the City of Murrieta accepts the supplemental grant award of the Fiscal Year 2023 Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant funds in the amount of \$93,423.75 and that the terms of the grant supplemental award are hereby accepted.
2. That the Fiscal Year 2025/26 Operating and CIP budgets, as adopted by Resolution No. 25-4836, are amended by establishing an expenditure and revenue appropriation of \$93,423.75 of grant funds and a local match of \$31,141.25 from the General Fund Capital (Fund 112) unassigned fund balance into CIP No. 10044.
