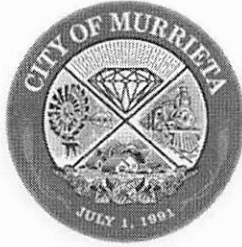

The following change(s) have been made to the bid documents, plans, and/or specifications posted on Planetbids and shall be incorporated into the bid. The referenced change(s) are as follows:

The following additional information shall be added to the Project Specifications and incorporated into the Contractors' bid.

301-1 SUBGRADE PREPARATION

301-1.1 GENERAL

[add the following]

The primary cause of disturbance/deterioration in many of the sidewalk panels and asphalt concrete sections identified for removal and replacement under this project is the intrusion of overgrown tree roots, which over time have lifted, displaced, and compromised the integrity of the existing concrete and asphalt surfaces. As identified in section 300-1.4, the Contractor will be responsible for all clearing & grubbing, root pruning, removals, and other associated items as described. Removal of tree roots and other clearing & grubbing activities may cause void spaces in the subgrade areas of removal requiring dirt import or aggregate base in order to fill the void spaces and accomplish the necessary grade for subgrade preparation and compaction.

The Contractor shall account for in their bid and be responsible for all cost associated with any necessary dirt import, aggregate base, and/or compaction associated with the removal of tree roots, clearing & grubbing, or other incidental activity causing void space prior to placement of concrete or asphalt concrete improvements.

Please note that the Contractor will not be responsible for tree removals. The City will perform any necessary tree removals down to the tree stump. The Contractor will be responsible for all other necessary clearing & grubbing activities described in the project specifications including root pruning/removal, tree stump removals, etc. Reference section **300-1.4** for further clarification on the payment clause associated with **Clearing & Grubbing** and other removals.

301-1.7 PAYMENT

[add the following]

All cost associated with necessary and incidental dirt infill or Caltrans Class 2 Aggregate base for concrete improvements, asphalt concrete improvements, or landscape restoration shall be included in the cost of various bid items and no additional compensation will be allowed, therefore.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Murrieta, Riverside County, California, will receive electronic sealed bids up to **2:00:00 p.m., on Thursday, the 30th day of April, 2026 (4/30/26)** on the City of Murrieta Vendor Portal through PlanetBids upon which time the bids will be opened electronically. The link to register as a bidder and electronically bid on this project can be found at the following address: www.MurrietaCA.gov/planetbids.

2. All of said work is to be performed in accordance with the Plans and Specifications entitled "FINAL – Citywide Sidewalk Replacement Program 2026, CIP No. 13064, MSD Project No. 26-003", which are available for purchase online at www.MurrietaCA.gov/planetbids. The cost is fifty dollars (\$50.00) (non-refundable) per set of Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents which must be purchased online. They cannot be purchased or mailed from City Hall. The bid package may be viewed at the Engineer Counter of City Hall located at 1 Town Square, Murrieta, California, 92562. For questions regarding the purchase of Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents please call: (951) 461-6008. 3. The contractor shall be licensed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3, of the Business and Professions Code. The classification of Contractor's license required in the performance of this Contract is: **Class A or C-8**

4. All contractors and subcontractors must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California (DIR) **prior** to submitting a bid on any public works project, pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. Bids from contractors and subcontractors that are not currently registered as required will be deemed nonresponsive. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR.

5. **PREVAILING WAGES:** Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1773 of the Labor Code of the State of California, City has obtained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work in this locality for each craft, classification, or type of workman needed to execute the contract from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations. These rates are on file with the City Clerk. Copies may be obtained at cost at the City Clerk's Office, City of Murrieta.

6. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish both a Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond to the City of Murrieta in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the Contract.

7. Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, the Contract will contain provisions permitting the successful bidder to substitute securities for any monies withheld by the City of Murrieta to ensure performance under the Contract.

8. **Each bidder must scan and submit the following documents (in addition to those listed in the Instructions to Bidders section 2 subsection L) with their electronic bid prior to the bid date and time listed above: Proposal Bid Package and Bid Bond at Ten Percent (10%) of the Base Bid (Bid Bonds will be on forms provided by the Contractor's surety).** The bidder can utilize a cashier's check in lieu of a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid. If a cashier's check is used, it shall be delivered to the City Clerk in a sealed envelope at 1 Town Square, Murrieta, CA 92562 prior to the bid date and time listed above.

9. The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the Plans, Exhibits, Specifications, and Contract Documents for the above-stated project. The general items of work to be done hereunder consist of maintenance, repair, and/or

reconstruction of City assets/infrastructure at various locations around the City including but not limited to: Concrete removal, clearing/grubbing, tree root and stump removals, installation of concrete sidewalks, installation of concrete curb & gutter, grinding of concrete sidewalk raised lips for conformance with ADA compliance, removal and replacement of failed/damaged section of asphalt concrete (AC digouts), pavement striping, landscape & irrigation restoration, traffic control, maintaining pedestrian and bicyclist access/safety, and other ancillary work at various Citywide locations all as shown on the Exhibits/Plans, City of Murrieta Standard Drawings, Standard Plans, and/or as specified in these project Specifications and Special Provisions.

10. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to delete portions of the work, or to waive any defect or informality in any bid received.

11. The Contractor and Subcontractors shall be subject to the requirements of Title 13: California Code of Regulations, Chapter 9: Off-Road Vehicles and Engines Pollution Control Devices, Article 4.8: In-Use Off-Road Diesel-Fueled Fleets sections 2449, 2449.1, and 2449.2. Contractors shall be required to abide by the requirements described in the referenced provisions and provide proof of their CARB Certificate(s) of Reported Compliance: In-Use Off-Road Diesel-Fueled Fleets.

12. The work to be performed shall be completed within **forty-five (45) working days** after execution of Contract and Notice to Proceed has been issued.

13. Contractors' activities shall be confined to the hours between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding City designated holidays. **The Contractor will be required to have all concrete work along Whitewood Rd. impacting pedestrian paths of travel complete prior to the start of the Murrieta Valley Unified School District school year starting on August 10th, 2026.**

14. There is NO pre-bid meeting for this project.

15. Contractors are encouraged to conduct a site visit/field walk of the entire site prior to submission of final bid. Contractor shall be responsible for having knowledge of existing site conditions.

16. The Engineer's Estimate for this project is **\$550,000**.

1. **SECURING DOCUMENTS**

Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents will be available for purchase **online from the City of Murrieta Vendor Portal through PlanetBids** at the following address: www.MurrietaCA.gov/planetbids. The cost is **fifty dollars (\$50.00)** (non-refundable) per set of Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents. The plans must be purchased online. They cannot be purchased or mailed from City Hall. The plans, however, may be viewed at Engineer Counter of City Hall located at 1 Town Square, Murrieta, California, 92562. 2. **PROPOSAL**

To receive consideration, bids shall be made in accordance with the following instructions:

- A. Bids shall be made upon the electronic proposal online from the City of Murrieta Vendor Portal through PlanetBids at the above referenced website address. **Paper copies will not be accepted.** The Bid Sheet included in the proposal is provided for reference and defines the basis of bid. The unit prices for each bid item shall be properly entered in the online electronic proposal. Bids shall be compared on the total of the Base Bid, unless otherwise defined in the Bid Sheet. In the event of discrepancies between the electronic proposal and the Bid Sheet, the electronic proposal shall govern. **The entire Proposal section shall be completed, scanned, and submitted with the online electronic proposal.**
- B. Bids shall be submitted only upon the items of bid stated in the Specifications; bids upon other basis will not be considered. Bids that do not reference all addenda or that are not submitted on the prescribed forms may be rejected.
- C. City reserves the right to accept bids on work and alternatives listed in the bid form in sum total or individually or in any combination, unless the bid form makes specific provision to the contrary.
- D. Unless called for, alternative bids will not be considered.
- E. Modification of bids shall be made online within the PlanetBids Vendor Portal prior to the bid date and time listed in the Notice Inviting Bids.
- F. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 4100 through 4113 of the Public Contracts Code of the State of California, every bidder shall, in his bid, set forth:
 - (1) The name, CSLB license number, CSLB license type, address, dollar amount of subcontract, description of work, and DIR registration number of each subcontractor who will perform work or labor or render service to the bidder in

or about the work in an amount in excess of one-half of one percent (0.5%) of the bidder's total bid.

- (2) The portion of the work that will be done by each such subcontractor. The Subcontractor List shall be provided with the online electronic proposal on the PlanetBids Vendor Portal. However, the bidder shall also execute and submit with their electronic bid proposal the "Subcontractor List" form included in the Proposal section for confirmation of compliance with the stated subcontractor requirements.
- G. In the event that alternative bids are called for and bidder intends to use different or additional subcontractors on the alternative or alternatives, he shall fill out additional forms of the Subcontractors List and shall indicate on such forms whether they apply to the base or alternative bids.
- H. If the bidder fails to specify a subcontractor for any portion of the work to be performed under the Contract in excess of one-half of one percent (.5%) of the bidder's total bid, he agrees to perform that portion himself. The successful bidder shall not, without the consent of City, either:
- (1) Substitute any person, firm, or corporation as subcontractor in place of the subcontractor designated in the original bid, or
 - (2) Permit any subcontract to be assigned or transferred or allow it to be performed by anyone other than the original subcontractor listed in the bid.
- I. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, or an acceptable bidder's bond for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid, made payable to the order of the City of Murrieta, California. Said check or bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into a Contract if awarded the work and in case of refusal or failure to enter into said Contract, the check or bond, as the case may be, shall be forfeited to the City of Murrieta, California. **If a bid bond is used, the form shall be by the issuing surety.** The bid bond shall be notarized and shall include a power of attorney.
- J. Before submitting a bid, bidders shall carefully examine the Plans, Specifications, and the form of Contract, shall visit the site of work, shall fully inform themselves as to all existing conditions and limitations, and shall include in the bid a sum to cover the cost of all items included in the Contract.
- K. Bidders shall give unit prices for each and all of the items set forth. No aggregate bids will be considered. The bidder shall set forth for each item of work, in clearly legible figures, a unit item price and a total for the item in the respective spaces provided for this purpose. The quantities listed in the Bid Sheets are supplied to give an indication of the general scope of work, but the accuracy of figures is not guaranteed, and the bidder shall make his own estimates from the Plans and Specifications. In case of a variation between the unit price and the totals shown by the bidder, the unit price will be considered to be the bid.

- California Air Resources Board (CARB) Acknowledgement Form

Two (2) wet signed, original copies of the above referenced documents shall be submitted to the City within three (3) business days of bid opening along with the following additional document:

- Insurance Documents/Certificate of Insurance

Within ten (10) business days of bid opening and upon the City's determination of the lowest responsible bidder, the City will issue a Public Works Construction Contract (see sample included in Exhibits). The selected Contractor shall submit a digital copy and two (2) wet signed original copies of the executed Public Works Construction Contract to the City within five (5) business days of Contract issuance.

3. MODIFICATIONS AFTER BID OPENING

A modification that is received from an otherwise successful bidder and that makes the terms of the bid more favorable to City will be considered at any time it is received and may thereafter be accepted.

4. WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

5. INTERPRETATION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

Should it be found that the point in question is not clearly and fully set forth, an Addendum will be issued online through the PlanetBids Vendor Portal to all persons receiving a set of documents. The City will not be responsible for any oral instructions.

6. ADDENDA OR BULLETINS

Any Addenda or information issued during the time of bidding, or forming a part of the documents loaned to the bidder for the preparation of his bid, shall be covered in the bid and shall be made a part of the Contract. All Addenda or Bulletins will be issued via email through the Planet Bids Vendor Portal. It is the Contractor's responsibility to ensure the email utilized in the Planet Bids Vendor Portal is current and accurate and it is further the Contractor's responsibility to actively check the email for Addenda or Bulletin updates.

7. OPENING OF BIDS

Bids will be opened electronically on the PlanetBids Vendor Portal, at the time and date set in the Notice Inviting Bids. Bidders will find the results online immediately after the bid date and time has expired.

8. AWARD OR REJECTION OF BIDS

If City awards the Contract, the award is made to the lowest responsible bidder. City reserves the right to reject the bid of any or all bidders, and to waive any informality in the bids received.

9. CONTRACT BONDS

9.1 **General.** Within ten (10) days after Notice of Award, Contractor shall file with the City Engineer surety bonds satisfactory to City in the amounts and for the purposes noted below. Bonds shall be duly executed by a responsible corporate surety, authorized to issue such bonds in the State of California and secured through an authorized agent with an office in California. Contractor shall pay all bond premiums, costs, and incidentals.

Each bond shall be signed by both Contractor and surety, and the signature of the authorized agent of surety shall be notarized.

Contractor shall provide two (2) good and sufficient surety bonds.

Surety companies shall familiarize themselves with all of the conditions and provisions of the Contract, and shall waive the right of special notification of change or modification of the Contract, or of any other act or acts by City of its authorized agents under the terms of the Contract. Failure to notify the surety companies of change shall in no way relieve them of their obligations under the Contract.

9.1.2 **Payment Bond.** The Payment Bond (material and labor) shall be for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price to satisfy claims of material suppliers and of mechanics and laborers employed by him on the work. The bond shall be maintained by Contractor in full force and effect until the completed work is accepted by City and until all claims for materials and labor are paid.

9.1.3 **Faithful Performance Bond.** The Faithful Performance Bond shall be for one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price to guaranty faithful performance of all work, within the time prescribed in a manner satisfactory to City, and that all materials and workmanship will be free from original or developed defects.

9.1.4 Bond Renewal and Extension. Should any bond become insufficient, Contractor immediately shall replace the bond with a substitute upon request from City, and the effective date of the bond shall be from the commencement of work on the project.

Should any surety at any time be unsatisfactory to City, notice will be given Contractor to that effect. No further payment shall be deemed due or will be made under the Contract, until a new surety shall qualify and be accepted by City.

Changes in the work or extension of time, made pursuant to the Contract, shall in no way release Contractor or surety from their obligations. Notice of such changes or extensions shall be waived by surety.

10. SPECIAL NOTICE

Bidders are required to inform themselves fully of the conditions relating to construction and labor under which the work will be performed, and Contractor must employ, so far as possible, such methods and means in the carrying out of his work as will not cause any interruption or interference with any other contractor.

11. BIDDERS INTERESTED IN MORE THAN ONE BID

No person, firm, or corporation shall be allowed to make or file or be interested in more than one (1) bid, as Prime Contractor for the same work. A person, firm, or corporation who has submitted a sub-proposal to a bidder, or who has quoted prices on materials to a bidder, is not hereby disqualified from submitting a sub-proposal or quoting prices to other bidders.

12. BIDS TO BE LEFT ON DEPOSIT

Unless otherwise required by law, no bid, nor any part thereof, may be withdrawn by the bidder for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the opening of the bids.

13. MANDATORY NON-COLLUSION AFFIDAVIT

- A. City will, before any award of the Contract is made, require any bidder to whom it may make an award of the principal Contract, to execute a Non-Collusion Affidavit.
- B. City may require that Principal Contractor shall, before awarding any subcontract, secure from the proposed subcontractor a Non-Collision Affidavit.

14. CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE

No bid may be considered from a Contractor who, at the time the bids are opened, is not licensed to perform the project in accordance with Division 3, Chapter 9, of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California. In the event of a dispute as to the classification of license required, the decision of the Contractor's State License Board shall prevail. This requirement is not a mere formality, and it will not be waived by City. The classification of Contractor's license required in the performance of this Contract is a **Class A or C-8**.

15. INSURANCE

1. **Commercial General Liability Insurance:** Insurance Services Office Form CG 00 01, including products and completed operations, with limits of no less than **\$2,000,000** per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage. If a general aggregate limit applies, either the general aggregate limit shall apply separately to this project/location or the general aggregate limit shall be twice the required occurrence limit.
 2. **Worker's Compensation** insurance as required by the State of California, with Statutory Limits, and Employers' Liability insurance with a limit of no less than **\$1,000,000** per accident for bodily injury or disease.
 3. **Automobile Liability:** Insurance Services Office Form Number CA 0001 covering Code 1 (any auto), with limits no less than **\$1,000,000** per accident for bodily injury and property damage.
 4. **Contractors' Pollution Legal Liability** and/or asbestos Legal Liability and/or Errors and Omissions (if project involves environmental hazards) with limits no less than **\$1,000,000** per occurrence or claim, and **\$2,000,000** policy aggregate.
 5. **Excess or Umbrella Liability Insurance (Over Primary)** if used to meet limit requirements, shall provide coverage at least as broad as specified for the underlying coverages. Such policy or policies shall include as insureds those covered by the underlying policies, including additional insureds. Coverage shall be "pay on behalf", with defense costs payable in addition to policy limits. There shall be no cross liability exclusion precluding coverage for claims or

suits by one insured against another. Coverage shall be applicable to CITY for injury to employees of CONTRACTOR, subcontractors or others involved in the Work. The scope of coverage provided is subject to approval of CITY following receipt of proof of insurance as required herein.

- B. **Deductibles and Self-Insured Retentions.** Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by CITY. At the option of CITY, either: CONTRACTOR shall cause the insurer to reduce or eliminate such deductibles or self-insured retentions as respects CITY, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers; or CONTRACTOR shall provide a financial guarantee satisfactory to CITY guaranteeing payment of losses and related investigations, claim administration, and defense expenses. The insurance policies are to contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions:
1. **CITY, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers are to be covered as additional insureds** on the CGL and automobile liability policies with respect to liability arising out of work or operations performed by or on behalf of CONTRACTOR including materials, parts, or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations and automobiles owned, leased, hired, or borrowed by or on behalf of CONTRACTOR. General liability coverage can be provided in the form of an endorsement to CONTRACTOR's insurance (at least as broad as ISO Form CG 20 10, 11 85 or both CG 20 10 and CG 23 37 forms if later revisions used).
 2. For any claims related to this project, **CONTRACTOR's insurance coverage shall be primary** insurance as respects CITY, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by CITY, its officers, officials, employees, or volunteers shall be in excess of CONTRACTOR's insurance and shall not contribute with it.
 3. Each insurance policy required by this clause shall provide that coverage shall not be canceled, except with notice to CITY.
- C. **Acceptability of Insurers.** Insurance is to be placed with insurers with a Bests' rating of no less than A:VII.
- D. **Waiver of Subrogation.** **CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to waive rights of subrogation which any insurer of CONTRACTOR may acquire** from CONTRACTOR by virtue of the payment of any loss. CONTRACTOR agrees to obtain any endorsement that may be necessary to effect this waiver of subrogation. **The Workers' Compensation policy shall be endorsed with a waiver of subrogation** in favor of CITY for all work performed by CONTRACTOR, its employees, agents and subcontractors.
- E. **Subcontractors.** CONTRACTOR shall include all subcontractors or shall furnish separate endorsements for each subcontractor. All coverage for subcontractors shall be subject to all the requirements stated herein.

16. **PERMITS**

17. PREVAILING WAGES

23. CONTRACTOR'S INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION

No plea of ignorance of conditions that exist or that may hereafter exist or of conditions of difficulties that may be encountered in the execution of work under this Contract, as a result of failure on initial investigations or reports prepared by City for purposes of letting this Contract out to bid, will be accepted as an excuse for any failure or omission on the part of Contractor to fulfill in every detail all requirements of this Contract. Nor will such reasons be accepted as a basis for any claims whatsoever for extra compensation or for an extension of time.

24. MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE

There is **no mandatory pre-bid conference** for this project.

25. BID PROTESTS

Any bid protest must be submitted in writing to the City Engineer before 5:00 P.M. on the tenth (10th) business day following the bid opening.
