

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-4835**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MURRIETA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025/26  
PROJECT LIST FOR THE USE OF FUNDS PROVIDED BY THE ROAD  
REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017 TO THE CALIFORNIA  
TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Murrieta are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, Murrieta must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, Murrieta, will receive an estimated \$2,904,570 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025/26 from SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the ninth year in which Murrieta is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable Murrieta to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, Murrieta used a Pavement Management Program to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help Murrieta maintain and rehabilitate approximately 1.6 miles of streets/roads throughout the City this year and similar projects into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2021 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that Murrieta's streets and roads are in good condition and this revenue will help the City increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will maintain our streets and roads in a good condition; and

**WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets

infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURRIETA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager of the City of Murrieta or his/her designee, is hereby authorized to submit an application to the California Transportation Commission for any and all funds that may become available to the City from the RMRA; and

**Section 2.** Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of the proposed project list that will be funded in-part or solely with fiscal year 2025/26 RMRA funds and previously proposed and adopted projects list which may utilize fiscal year 2024/25, fiscal year 2023/2024 and fiscal year 2022/2023 RMRA funds, and is approved by the City Council; and

**Section 3.** The City Manager or his/her designee, is hereby authorized as Signature Authority to execute all documents necessary to implement and secure any and all funds that may become available to the City from the RMRA.

Project Title:	Pavement Resurfacing – Asphalt Overlay
Project Location:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Clinton Keith Road from 650' West of Spinning Wheel Drive to Greer Road</li></ul>
Description:	This project will resurface 1.6 miles of Clinton Keith Road from 650' west of Spinning Wheel Drive to Greer Road. The proposed project will include resurfacing with hot mix asphalt.
FY 25/26 Appropriation Amount:	\$2,904,570
Estimated Useful Life:	10 years
Proposed Schedule for Completion:	FY 2026/27

**FY 2025/26 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account Fund Previously Proposed and Adopted Project List**

Project Title:	Pavement Resurfacing – Asphalt Overlay
Project Location:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Clinton Keith Road from Greer Road to Whitewood Road**</li></ul>
Description:	This project will resurface 1.4 miles of Clinton Keith Road from Greer Road to Whitewood Road. The proposed project will include resurfacing with hot mix asphalt.
FY 24/25 Appropriation Amount:	\$2,833,125
Estimated Useful Life:	10 years
Proposed Schedule for Completion:	FY 2026/27

\*\* Project was previously identified as Clinton Keith Road from 650' West of Spinning Wheel Drive to Whitewood Road, totaling 3.0 miles. Project was determined to be too large based on available funding sources. As a result, the project has been split into two projects covering the same limits of roadway. Pavement resurfacing for Clinton Keith Road from 650' west of Spinning Wheel Drive to Greer Road shall be a standalone project.

Project Title: Pavement Resurfacing – Asphalt Overlay

Project Location:

- Jefferson Avenue from Murrieta Hot Springs Road to Lemon Street; and
- Jefferson Avenue from Lily Avenue to Ballestros Road.

Description: This project will resurface 1.5 miles of Jefferson Avenue from Murrieta Hot Springs Road to Lemon Street and 0.9 miles of Jefferson Avenue from Lily Avenue to Ballestros Road. The proposed projects will include resurfacing with hot mix asphalt.

FY 23/24 Appropriation Amount: \$2,748,470

Estimated Useful Life: 10 years

Proposed Schedule for Completion: FY 2025/26

Project Title: Pavement Resurfacing – Asphalt Overlay

Project Location:

- Los Alamos Road from Lincoln Avenue to I-215;
- Antelope Road from Mapleton Avenue to Heritage Marketplace Traffic Signal;
- Elm Street from Jefferson Avenue to Adams Avenue; and
- Cherry Street from Jefferson Avenue to Adams Avenue.

Description: This project will resurface 0.7 miles of Los Alamos Road from Lincoln Avenue to I-215, 0.6 miles of Antelope Road from Mapleton Avenue to Heritage Marketplace Traffic Signal, 0.3 miles of Elm Street from Jefferson Avenue to Adams Avenue, and 0.3 miles of Cherry Street from Jefferson Avenue to Adams Avenue. Los Alamos Road and Antelope Road will include resurfacing with rubberized hot mix asphalt. Elm Street and Cherry Street may include recycled asphalt with hot mix asphalt overlay.

Estimated Useful Life: 10 years

Proposed Schedule for Completion: FY 2025/26
