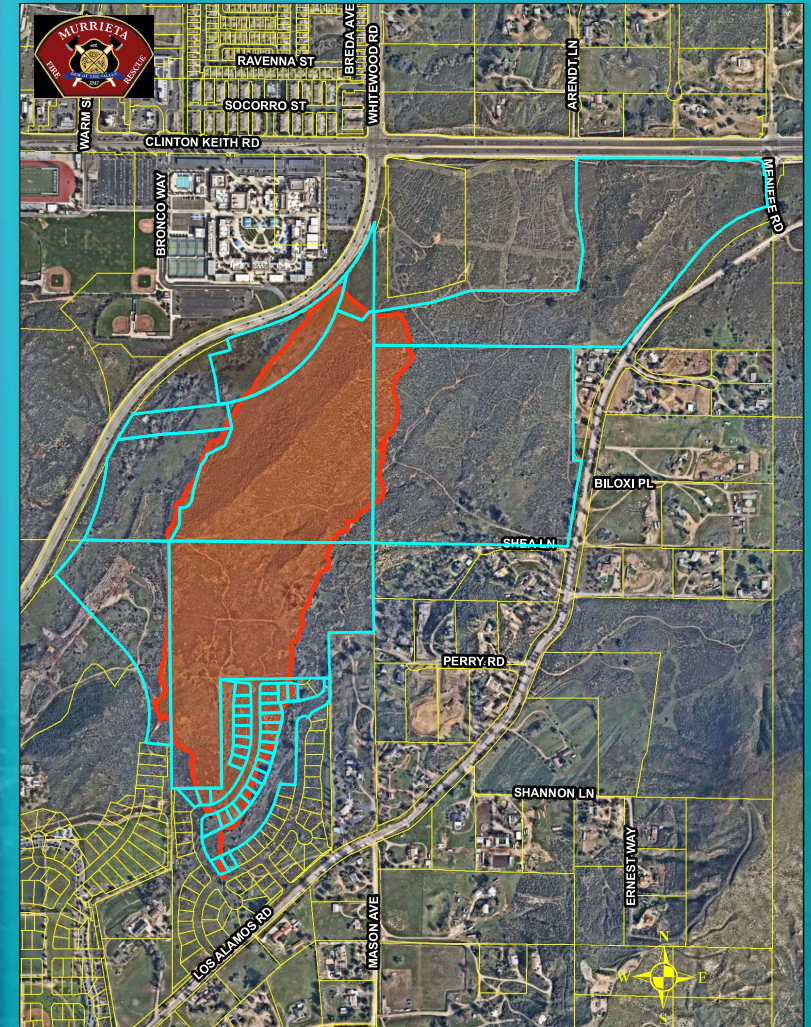

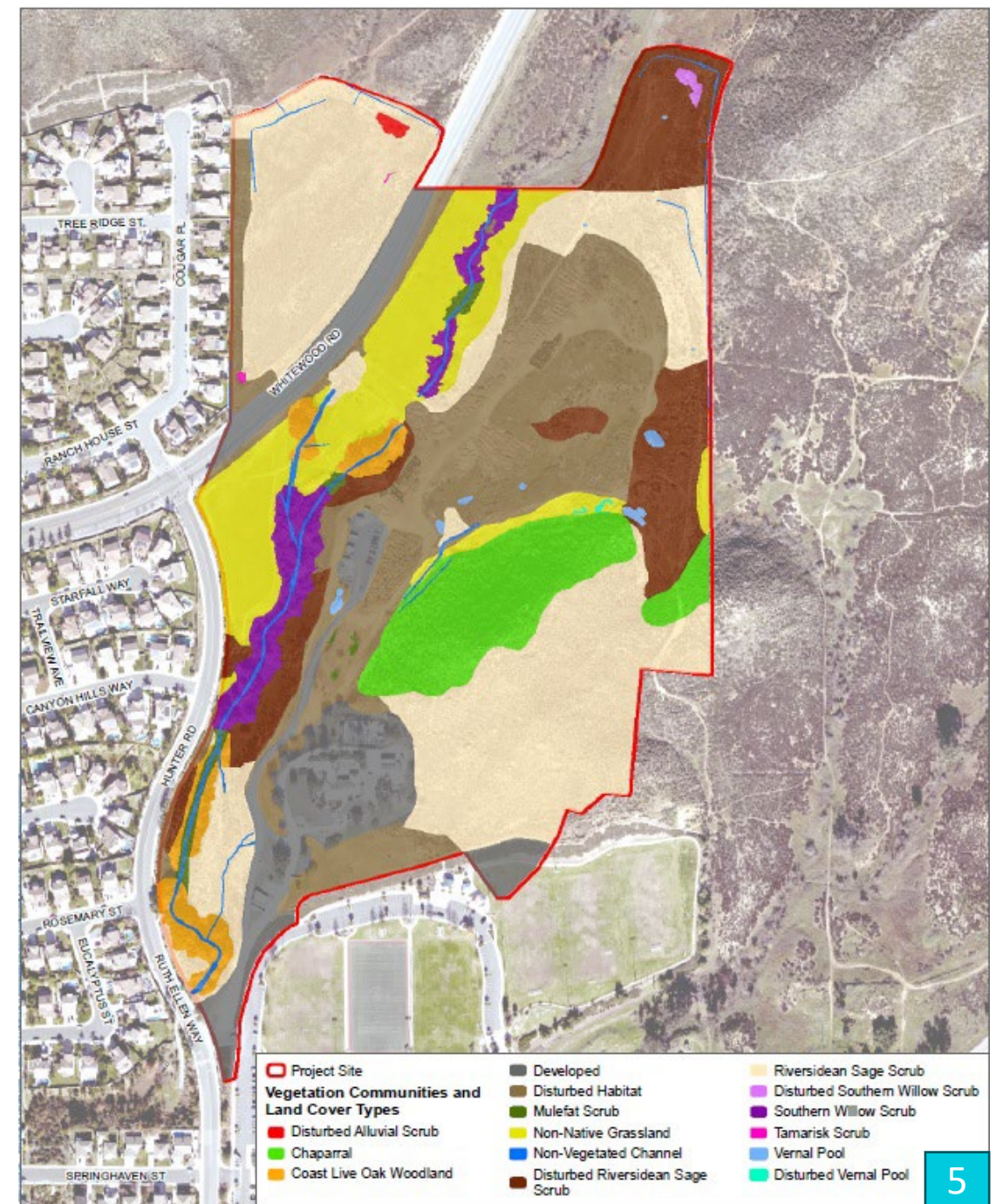
Environmental Setting

Land use: Maintenance (green waste), open space

Hydrology: Santa Margarita Watershed (De Luz Hydrologic Area) and one unnamed creek

Vegetation communities:

1. Vernal pools
2. Non-vegetated channel
3. Mulefat scrub
4. Southern willow scrub
5. Tamarisk scrub
6. Riversidean sage scrub
7. Disturbed alluvial scrub
8. Chaparral
9. Coast live oak woodland
10. Non-native grassland



Sensitive Species Surveys

1. Least Bell's Vireo

2. Southwestern Willow Flycatcher

3. Vernal Pool Branchiopods (*fairy shrimp*)

- 2019–2020 wet season
- 2021–2022 wet season
- 2022 dry season

4. Coastal California Gnatcatcher

5. Western Burrowing Owl

6. Stephens' Kangaroo Rat

7. Crotches Bumblebee 2024

(candidate for California Endangered Species Act (CESA))
