- MFR's oldest front-line apparatus is 22 years old, well past it's serviceable front-line life span.
- The Fleet replacement plan has a Type 1 apparatus in the CIP this year.

Background

- Pierce Fire Apparatus was selected to maintain continuity within our fleet.
- This purchase will standardize the type 1 engines we use at MFR.
- Improves efficiencies of training, operations, and maintenance.

Funding

- Utilize Murrieta Municipal Code 3.08.295 Cooperative Purchasing to access NPP.GOV cooperative purchasing price.
- Current Funding in place within the CIP – Funded by Measure T: \$1,400,000.00
- Vehicle Price: \$1,168,684.38
- Upfitting with Radios and equipment: \$230,000.00
- Cost not to exceed: \$1,400,000.00
- PO issued to secure the vehicle but it will not be funded until delivery.
- Delivery is 45-48 months from date of signed contract. (4 years!)

Recommendation
